Why and why now?

- Experience not documented often gets lost and forgotten
- If made available for the broad community, it can save valuable time and lives for those in crisis situations
- For whom:
 - those who rebuild or maintain their networks after damage
 - those who are planning future networks and want to built in resiliency from the start
