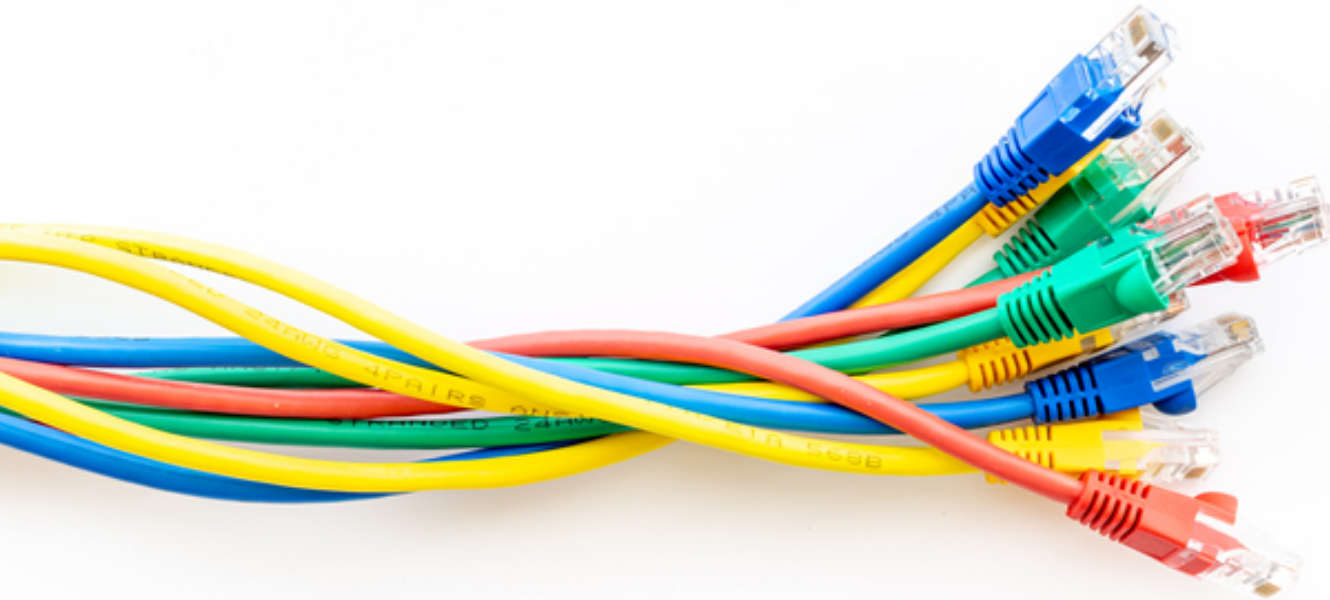

# RIPE 86: Hybrid Meetings Are Here to Stay



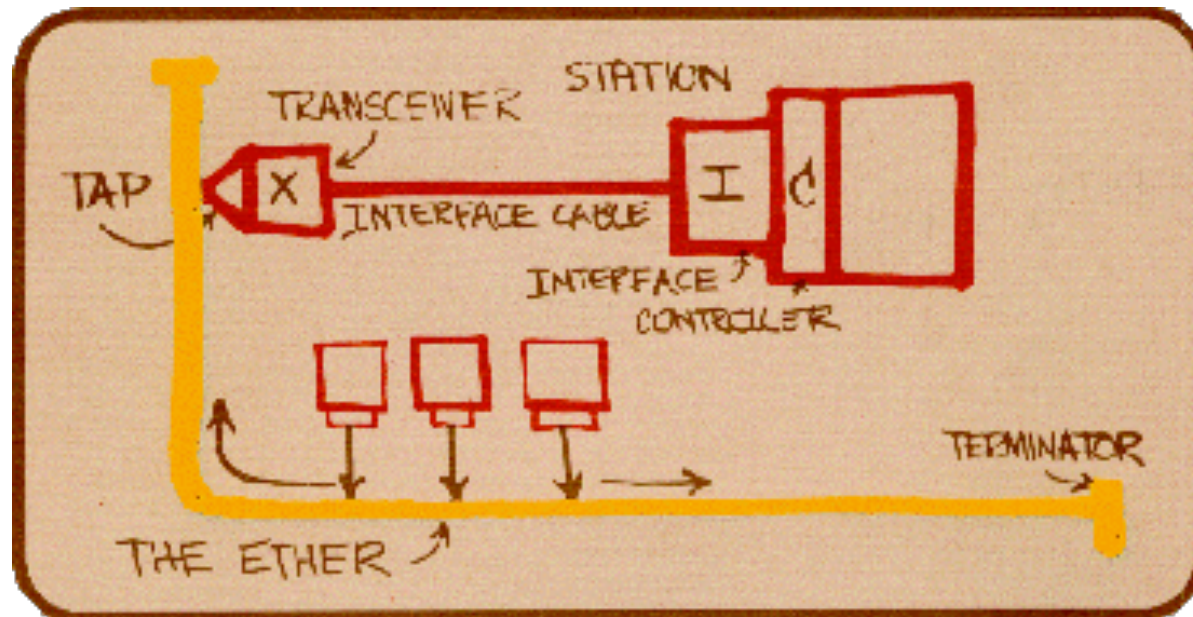
**RIPE 86**
